In <i>Farewell to Manzanar</i> , Jeanne Wakatsuki Houston tells the story of her family's time at Manzanar, a Japanese internment camp, during WWII, as well as about their experiences after they are allowed to leave the camp and eventually settle in San Jose. This book allows us to teach more about the Asian American experience in the United States, including various anti-immigrant efforts against both the Chinese and Japanese and racial profiling of Japanese Americans during WWII, and address some of the ongoing issues of racial profiling in our society today. It also allows students to learn more about California history, read a local author's work, and hear first-hand speaker accounts.

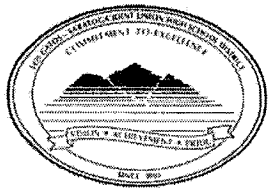
